Keep a Book Log

Keeping a book log can be a helpful in so many way. It allows you to track what you read. It hones critical thinking skills. It helps articulate why you liked (or didn't like) a particular book--which makes explaining to you friends why they should read a book much easier! And it can be fun to look back over a year and see everything you've read.

Moreover, book logs can be as simple or as complicated as you like. You can use special books designed just for this, a sketch book, or a simple three-ring binder stuffed with lined paper. You can give ratings, use word descriptions, and include pictures. It is truly up to you; there is no right or wrong. Here's one example:

If you can recommend this book, whom do you think should read it and why?

Optional: Add a sketch of favorite character, location, or other cool element.

The key is have fun and to provide enough information that you can find the book again if you want to!

Leave reviews on sites like Amazon, Barnes & Noble, Goodreads, and Christianbook.com. Outside of buying books, this is one of the best ways to help your favorite authors. Even just a starred rating helps! Don't know what to write? The questions in this reading log works as a great guideline.



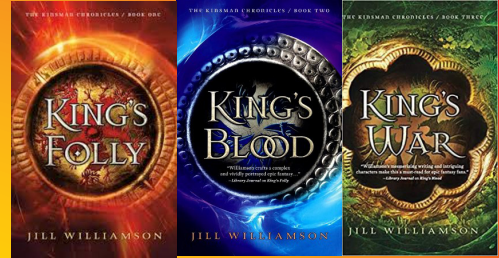

Create a bed of crushed tortilla chips. Add cooked hot dog (sliced or whole) and cover warmed chili. Top with shredded cheese, diced onion, and sour cream.

*Easy Meals for Busy Readers #3:
Nachoes*

Cook hamburger. Add cheese sauce. Salsa or diced tomatoes and olives. Heat until hot. Top with lettuce shreds. Serve with tortilla chips and apple slices.

Easy Meals for Busy Readers #4: Build-Your-Own-Salad

Set out salad dressings, a bowl of greens (lettuce, spring, spinach, or combo thereof) lettuce and/or spinach, and dishes of toppings, to let each person create their own salad. Possible toppings could include cheese, crutons, fresh chopped vegetables (carrots, celery, bell peppers), olives, chopped nuts & seeds (walnuts, pecans, almonds, chia seeds, pumpkin, sunflower, etc.), apples, berries, and meat (canned chicken, shredded beef, sliced ham or other lunch meat).
